Government Grants \$1.35m for Bluecliffs Landfill Clean Up

26 February 2024 : Advocate South & The Southland App

The government has granted \$1.35 million, from the Contaminated Sites Remediation Fund, to clean up the Bluecliffs landfill site - which is currently under a local State of Emergency due to severe erosion.

The fund can be applied for by regional councils and unitary authorities to secure contaminated sites that pose a risk to human health and the environment. Environment Minister and Invercargill MP Penny Simmonds announced the grant on Saturday (24 Feb) as part of \$6.6 million in funding to clean up four low-lying coastal landfill and dump sites in Gisborne, Southland, Canterbury and Nelson. "I am pleased to make this funding available to the Tuatapere community."

"It will address the risk of this site being breached by a natural event, exposing waste material and contaminating the surrounding land and waterways," Simmonds said.

"This site, which is in a low-lying coastal area, is at risk of being compromised by storm surges, rainfall events, high water levels and flooding. This is a significant and proactive environmental initiative which aims to mitigate the risks of erosion and contamination in the wake of extreme weather events and climate change, as the Government safeguards coastal communities and ecosystems, like those at Bluecliffs."

"The Bluecliffs landfill site is situated in a former gravel pit located within Te Waewae Bay, west of the Waiau River mouth."

"Waste material was dumped at the site from the 1970s through to the 1980s, and fly-tipping, including larger items such as electrical appliances, car parts and plastic crates, were also dumped there."

"Coastal tides and Waiau River mouth flooding have eroded parts of the site and surrounding areas."

"Environment Southland is partnering with Southland District Council to plan and undertake remediation of the site, and this new funding will support that work."





How fortunate were we that Tuatapere was chosen for this scientific study of the number of different species in our Domain Reserve area!

I'm hoping that many of you will have been involved in some way, even if it be as an observer.

As a State of Emergency was declared due to erosion at the Waiau Mouth a meeting was held for Waiau Mouth residents led by Simon Mapp, Emergency Management Controller and representatives from Environment Southland and Southland District Council.

Residents were informed of the recovery process which includes a physical opening of the bar at the Mouth to manage the river flow and an attempt to remove a community landfill which has continued to erode into the sea. The positivity, the good local knowledge and the patience of the 'Mouth' community throughout the whole process has been greatly appreciated.

Tuatapere Railway Station. A Request for Information document is now available calling for Expressions of Interest for the future use. The document is available at southlanddc.govt.nz (under Public Notices) or by hard copy at the Tuatapere Library, Tui Base Camp café, The Well café or Boundary Creek Café. Voluntary repair work has been taking place by Wayne Edgerton and helpers. An allocation of Better-off Funding by the govt (\$310,000) will help further refurbishment, and a Trust may be formed to facilitate ongoing funding/maintenance.

The Community Board is in the process of planning the planting of natives on McLeod's Track where dying trees were removed in 2023.

Priorities from the Main Street Development Plan (community consultation 2022) will be addressed.

CELEBRATING OUR MILESTONES

For a small district Community Archive, CWA has been punching above its weight when getting recognition from local, regional and national audiences in the heritage field. It has also secured over \$50k of funding for its community heritage preservation initiative.

We are rightly proud of our achievements, which we have listed below to share with others:

1 June 2022 - the CWA online Community Archive was established with KPIs for a 6-month trial

19 April 2023 – TDPI (Tūātapere Promotions) signs agreement with CWA for governance

15 May 2023 – CWA Online Collection in eHive reaches over 10k views for the first time

6 June 2023 – CWA obtains first \$15k of funding for a DigiHub from Meridian Power Up

23 June 2023 – CWA takes over old Tūātapere Plunket Rooms so they can open to public

6 September 2023 - CTS funds the last large chunk of \$7.6k needed for CWA new DigiHub

11 September 2023 - Lotteries Board awards CWA \$21.4k to set up a Public Heritage Hub

2 October 2023 - start of Partnership with DOC Murihiku to share their historical archives

13 Oct 2023 - CWA officially opens to the Public with a large event of Heritage attendees

27 Nov 2023 - CWA takes delivery of DigiHub to professionally preserve district heritage
